The McClosky Institute of Voice is pleased to announce the first year of its next Certification Course cycle this summer of 2023. Because of your familiarity with the McClosky Technique – through your experience in a seminar, workshop, or private study with a Certified McClosky Voice Technician (CMVT) – you are invited to apply for this course.

The course takes place in two 7-day sessions over consecutive summers, in conjunction with the MIV summer seminar; two online courses with on-site reviews and exams are also included each year. This year's on-site session will be July 9-16 at Salem State University in Massachusetts.

If you are interested in learning more about the McClosky Technique, please consider applying. During the course, you will be engrossed in learning vocal anatomy, physiology, and voice disorders. You will learn how to embody the technique to improve your personal vocal production, and how to teach the technique to those who use their voices in a variety of ways.

ABOUT McCLOSKY CERTIFICATION

CMVT: Certified McClosky Voice Technician

Two-year Certification Training Course – 120 Hours

Year One: July 2023



The McClosky Technique has been used successfully worldwide for more than 60 years. Developed in the 1940s and 1950s by David Blair McClosky, pioneer in the field of voice science and vocal rehabilitation, this technique provides a complete system of healthy vocal production for song and speech, by incorporating body alignment, breath management, and relaxation exercises to free tensions that have a negative effect on the voice.

The McClosky Institute of Voice, founded in 1981, is dedicated to the enhancement of the healthy voice and the remediation of voice disorders. Certified McClosky Voice Technicians are voice teachers, singers, actors, music educators, choral conductors, and speech language pathologists.



Who is Invited to Apply:

Those familiar with McClosky Technique through one or more of the following:

- Experience in a seminar or workshop of the McClosky Institute of Voice (MIV)
- Private study with a Certified McClosky Voice Technician (CMVT)
- Participation in a group conducted by a CMVT
- AND, a bachelor's or equivalent degree in voice, music education, speech, or a related field (significant professional experience may also be considered)

Certification Training Course Description:

- In depth study of the McClosky Technique as presented in *Your Voice at Its Best*, by David Blair McClosky, 5th Edition.
- Two 7-day sessions over consecutive summers, in conjunction with the MIV summer seminar
- Lectures, exams, master classes, group discussions, private lessons, assignments between summer sessions, teacher training, and teaching practicum in the seminar
- Individual technical and hands-on instruction with MIV master teachers to improve vocal production and gain personal embodiment of the technique
- Detailed instruction in anatomy, physiology, voice disorders, professional ethics and vocabulary for interaction with other voice professionals (two online courses each year with Zoom review and home exam)
- Development of the skills to identify and solve vocal faults using the McClosky Technique





Certification Training Course Requirements:

- Proficiency – explain, demonstrate, and embody proper posture, breathing for phonation, and relaxation of extrinsic laryngeal muscles, as presented through McClosky technique
- Successful completion of written examinations in vocal anatomy, physiology, and voice disorders
- Successful completion of home assignments given between summer sessions
- Teaching practicum with instructor conferences and evaluations
- Performance in demonstration concert – preparation of vocal repertoire (singing, acting, or oratory) and applying the McClosky Technique to personal voice use
